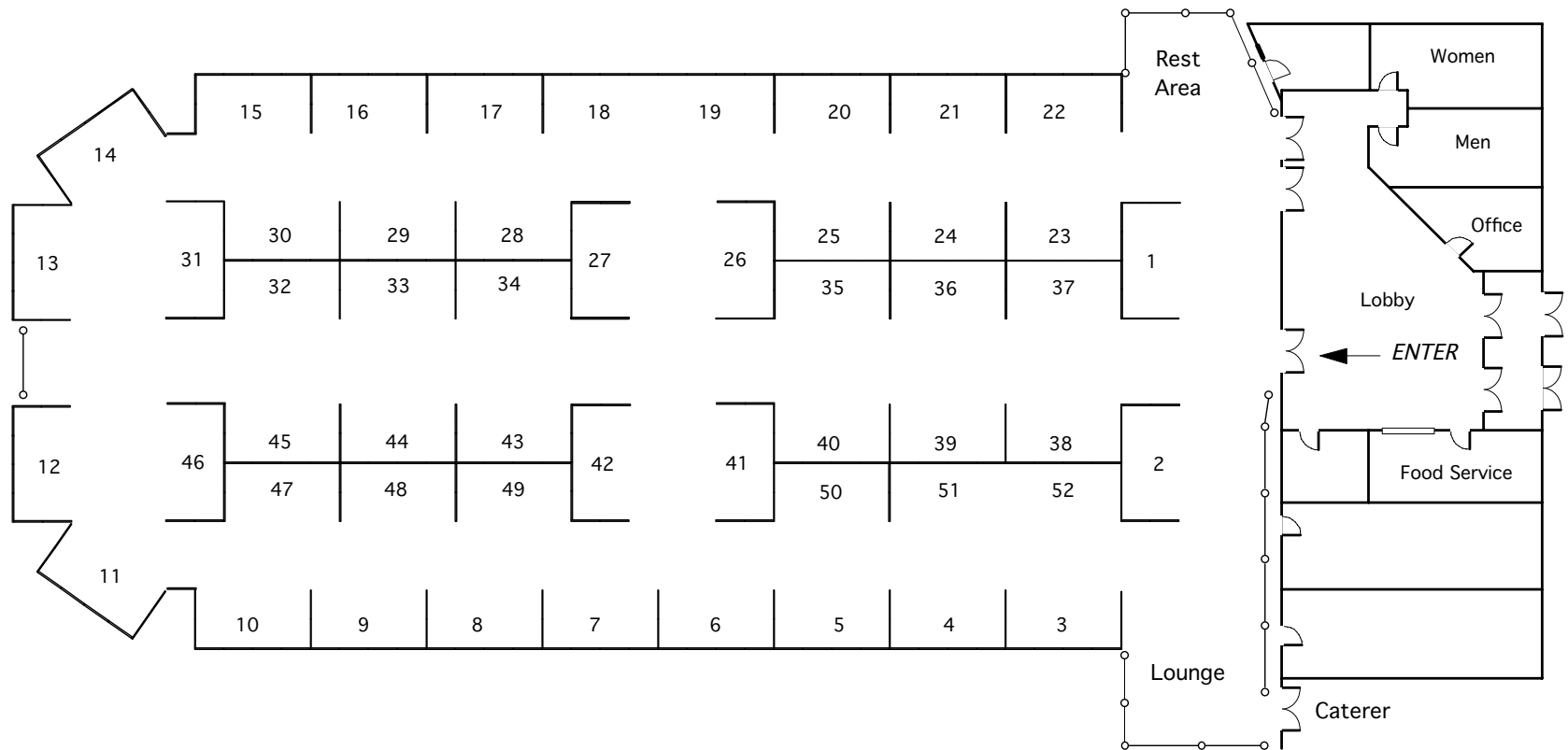

HENRY T. CALLAN ANTIQUES, East Sandwich, Mass. — This Massachusetts sampler was made by Abigail Stratton, aged 14, in 1828 and it includes three alphabets, two baskets of fruit and a flowering bush within a strawberry and vive border. It is dated and measures 18 by 11 inches.



DBR ANTIQUES, Doug Ramsay, Hadley, Mass. — Small, graphic gameboard with carved molded edge, dry original paint, dating from the late Nineteenth Century.



THAT WICKER GUY, St Albans Bay, Vt. — Heywood Wakefield child's carriage. This most unusual and rare piece is designed to resemble an English horse-drawn carriage or coach.



GARDINER'S ANTIQUES, South Burlington, Vt. — Watercolor landscape by Alexander Charles Robinson (1867-1952).



WEST PELHAM ANTIQUES, Pelham, Mass. — Miniature paint-decorated, dovetailed blanket box in the original salmon paint with till and molded foot rim. It dates circa 1840-50 and the initials "HM" are worked into the swirl pattern on the lid (almost like finger paint decoration).

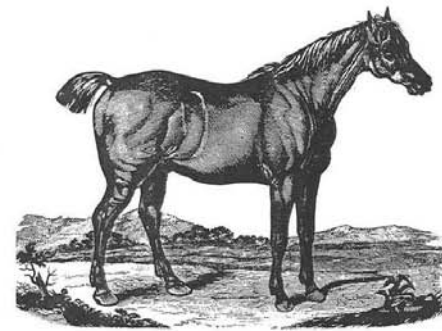

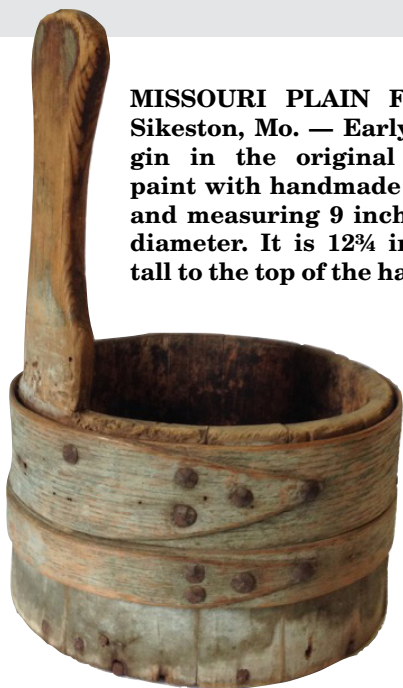

JANICE GOODWIN, HINESBURG, Vt. — Brown, black and red painted one-drawer stand with impressed numbered squares, on a folksy, multicolored wool penny rug depicting three-tier pennies with French knot design. It measures 27 by 38 inches.

DERIK PULITO, Kensington, Conn. — A William and Mary double arched two-drawer chest (faux five drawers), in early red paint. An estate find from an early family in Guilford, Conn. An almost identical chest is owned by the New Haven Colony Historical Society: plate 51 — *Connecticut Furniture Seventeenth and Eighteenth Centuries*.



STEPHEN-DOUGLAS ANTIQUES, Rockingham, Vt. — This blue bucket bench cupboard, Canadian, dates from the Nineteenth Century.

DBR ANTIQUES, Doug Ramsay, Hadley, Mass. — Lollipop top looking glass in cherry, circa 1800, in all original condition.



WEST PELHAM ANTIQUES, Pelham, Mass. — Roxana Holmes needlework sampler, 1830, probably New England and measuring 19 by 17 inches sight, frame size (not the original frame, but appropriate) 20 by 18 inches. A charming rendition of a fashionably dressed young girl holding flowers and flanked by Greek columns.

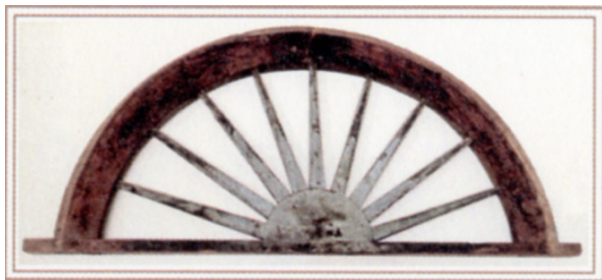

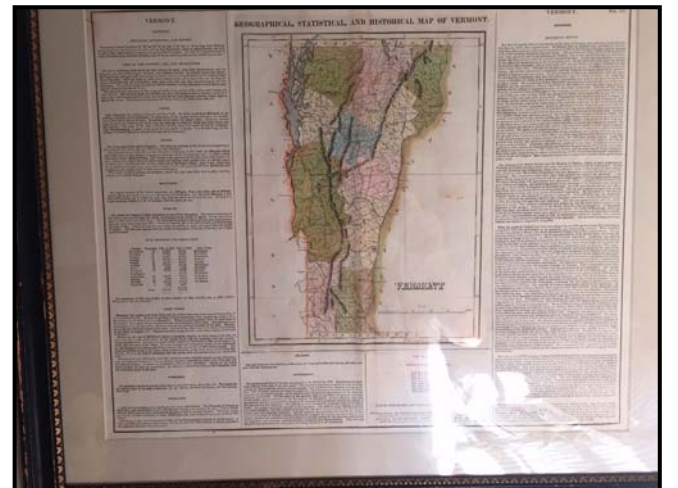

DERIK PULITO, Kensington, Conn. — This writing-arm Windsor fanback, Eastern, Connecticut, is probably by E. Tracy, circa 1790. Typical hardwood used at their chair making shop, and used in this chair, were butternut, chestnut, poplar seat, along with ash spindles and maple legs and posts. This chair is all original, was refinished probably 100 ago, and measures 17¾ inches seat height, 43 inches tall, and 36-inch span.

WEST PELHAM ANTIQUES, Pelham, Mass. — A New England wooden handbox, covered with hand painted wallpaper in striking colors and measuring 16 by 12 inches, 9½ inches high. The interior is covered with a circa 1840 Massachusetts newspaper (*The Telegraph* — probably Worcester, Mass.). It is solid with only very minor paper loss on the edges.

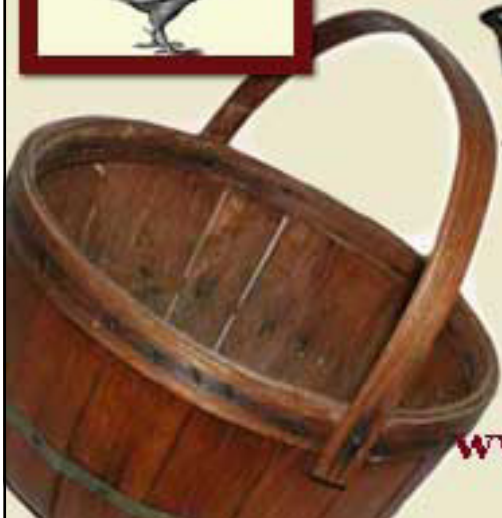
