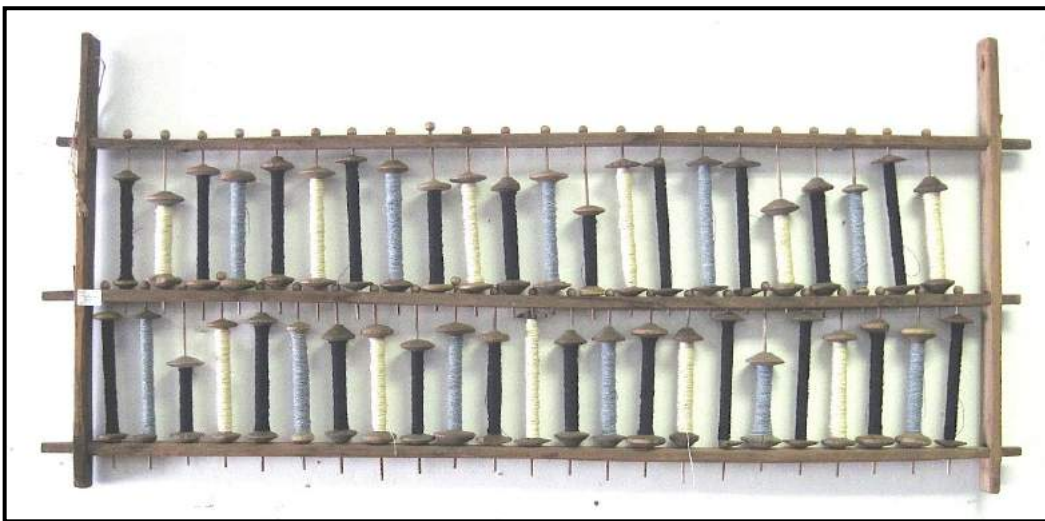

Labeled Vermont decorated furniture is fairly rare. This stencil-decorated late Sheraton chair is from a matched set of four, all in exceptional original condition - signed on the back of each “D. M. Tuthill - Saxton's Village, Vermont.” Daniel M. Tuthill was a resident of Rockingham in 1833, and a furniture, looking glass and frame manufacturer in the Saxton's River section of Rockingham in the 1840's.

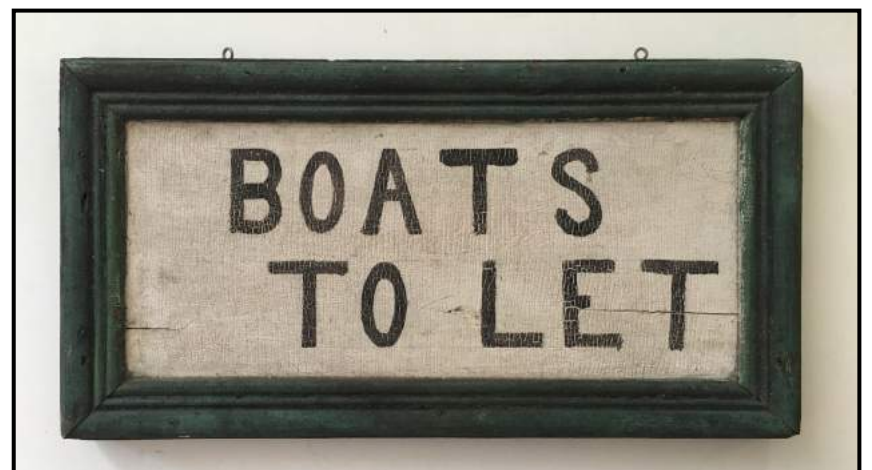
