Fabulous quality late 18th/early 19thC Flemish 21" x 25 1/2" o/c still life of fruit & flowers in Delft bowl. This great painting was found unframed & unstretched amidst a portfolio of additional artwork & assorted papers.

Humphrey's "Thomas Elfe - Cabinet Maker" (identical chest on the cover) - This chest features orig brasses, locks & key with Cypress secondary wood & Chinese Chippendale lazy eight blind fretwork - upper case width 40 3/4" - lower case width 43" - 76" tall
