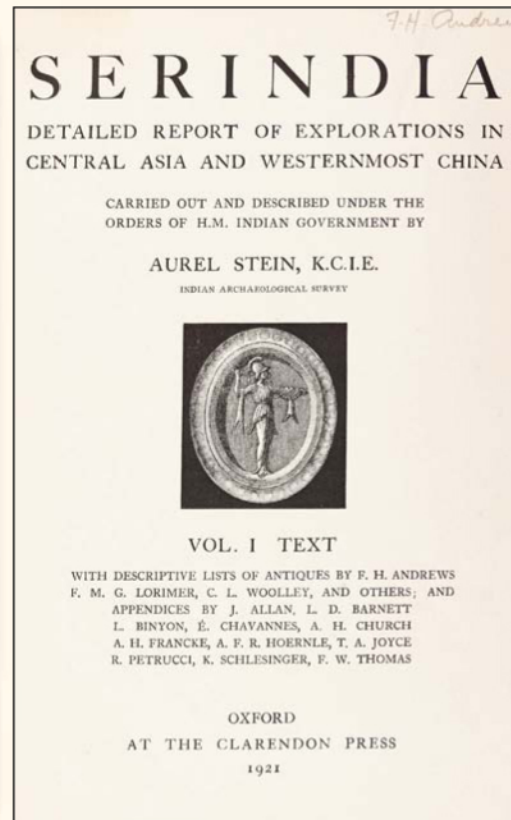
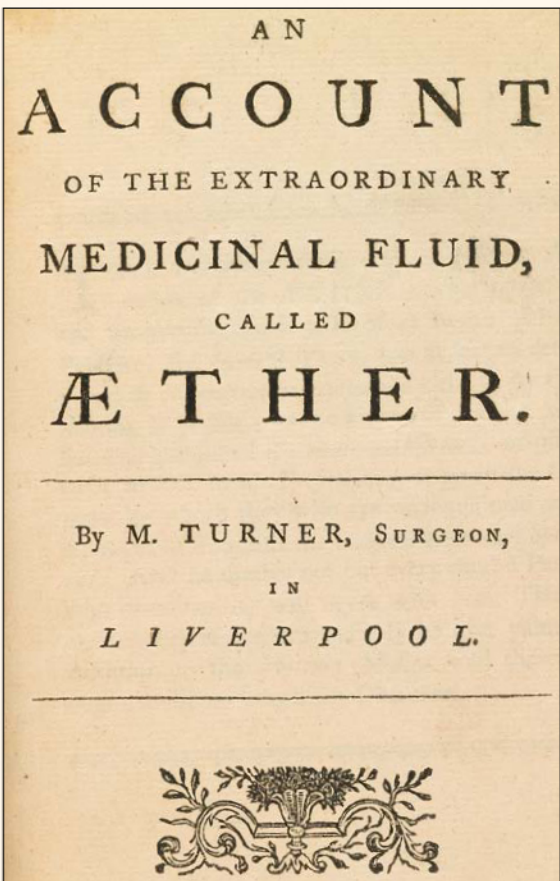




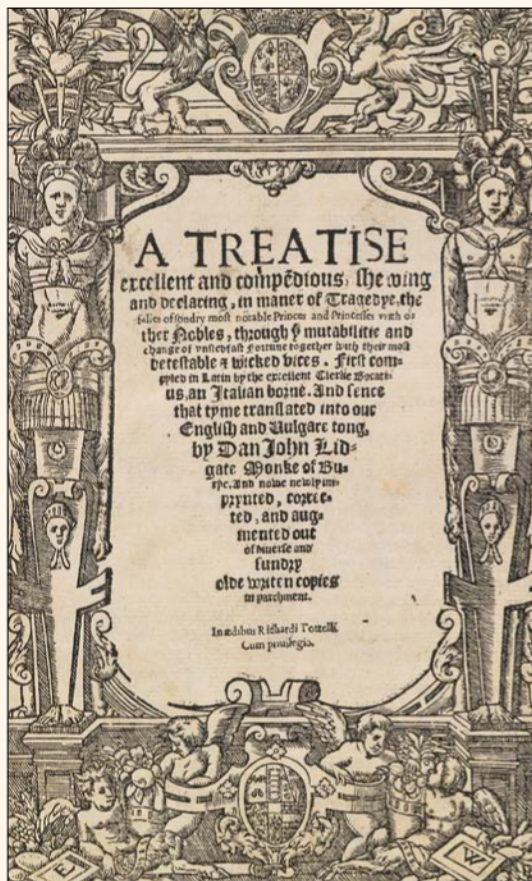
Nova legenda Anglie, London: Wynkyn de Worde, 1516. Estimate \$8,000 to \$12,000.



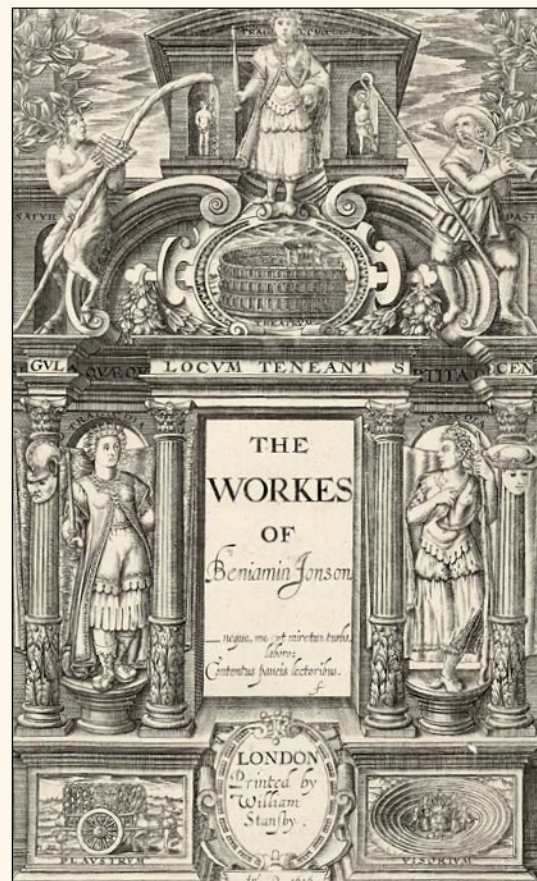
