





Ian Fleming, Moonraker, first edition, first state, in first issue dust jacket, London, (1955). Estimate \$3,500 to \$5,000.




Vladimir Nabokov, *Lolita*, first edition, first issue, two volumes, Paris, (1955). Estimate \$4,500 to \$6,000.



Mark Twain, Adventures of Huckleberry Finn, first American edition, New York, 1885. Estimate \$3,500 to \$5,000.




