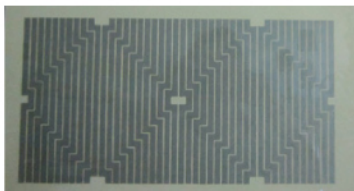

Directions: From Merritt Parkway, Exit 38 (Rt 123/New Canaan Avenue), go north on 123 for 1.9mi, turn left onto East Avenue (Rt 106), turn right onto Rt 124 (Main Street), and continue north for 0.7 mi on Rt 124 (name changes to Oenoke Ridge Road). Follow signs to parking on Oenoke at Presbyterian Church lot opposite Roger Sherman Inn. Shuttle service to the sale house on Lambert Road will be available from the church lot.
