He was the brother of Ex-Governor Charles H. Sawyer of Dover, NH. He was educated at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, and the University of Gottingen, Germany. Last 15 years of his life were devoted to the study of art in New York, Paris, Berlin and Florence. His works have been admitted to the exhibitions of New York Academy, Royal Academy, and Paris Salon.
