


### Recent Discovery: IRA CHAFFEE GOODELL, attr. (1800-c.1875)

Edward Bowne Willets (1837-1916), born in New York City to Daniel Titus Willets and Elizabeth Farrington (Bowne) Willets, had a career in maritime commerce in the family business, Willets & Co., in Manhattan. In his later years, he became an avid student of local colonial history and collector of antique furniture and "bric-a-brac" for his home in Brooklyn. Acquired from estate of a direct descendant. Extensive background and genealogy provided.

The sampler is all original including the frame, glass and backboard. It has provenance connected it to a prominent family in Andover and connections to Phillips Academy founders in Andover.

(The verse is)  
*Lydia Abbot Performer*  
Of this age 9 years Born November 4, 1800  
My Life is a compound of freedoms  
I go where I will and return when I please  
I live above envy also above strife  
And wish I had judgment to choose a good life.

This sampler was begun May 24 and finished July 3  
at Miss Phebe Abbots School in Andover.  
{A large flower, a tree with two hearts  
and under the tree and another large flower}.  
12½" by 15½" and with frame 16" by 19½".  
The sampler has some age related toning and a small hole at the very top.
