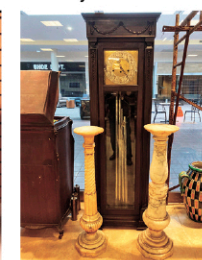

Ansonia Swing Arm 19c (Huntress Diana) Mantle Clock in excellent condition. Rare.



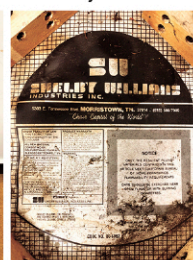

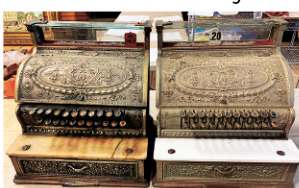

3 cast iron 1890's American Jardineers.



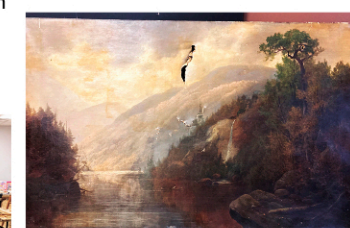
2 - 332 model National solid brass cash registers, 1900s made for a Syracuse country store. Needs restoration, out of an estate.

Orton Preston 1800s Farmington, Conn. 2 weight driven time + strike clock with key and pendulum.



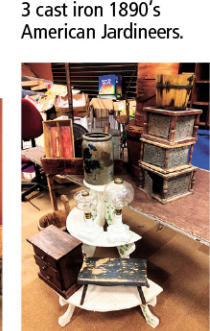
