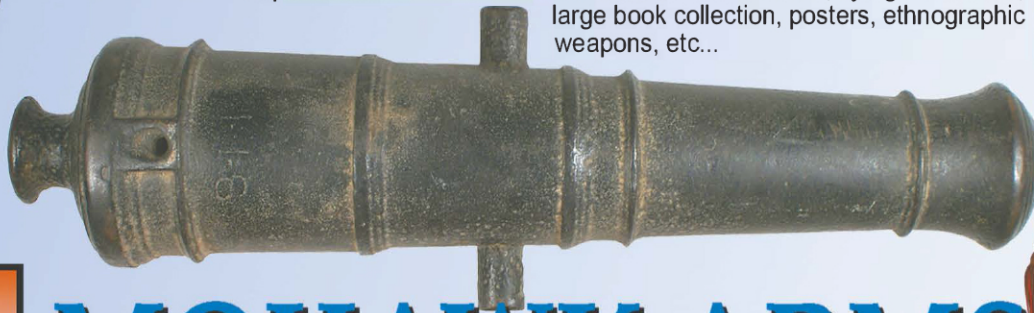

Auction 86 includes:  
a "WHITE STAR" uniform button from the coat of  
Titanic survivor Charles Weikman, the chief barber on the ill fated liner (with  
provenance). Letters, photos, ephemera from the personal possessions  
of Rear Admiral Richard E. Byrd, an American naval hero, polar  
explorer and recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor.;  
American Colonial cannon 1740-1780; Imperial German helmets  
including the helmet of Prinz Alfons of Bavaria as Honorary  
Regimental Commander of the 5th Prussian Dragoon Regiment  
"Freiherr von Manteuffel" - with dress feather bush and 4 original  
photos (1 autographed), 4 photo postcards (1 autographed) and  
several other ephemera items, Prussian Jager/Schutzen officer  
dress shako, Garde Uhlan "tschapka" (felt body), Baden  
Artillery officer, etc.; Regimental steins (including a rare  
"Jager Regiment zuPferde"), medals, swords (Bavarian  
Court, Kurrasier No. 7 officer, etc.), German WWI  
aviation Pokol, collection of Wilhelm II family and circa 1900  
opera/actors photo postcards; European flint and percussion  
pistols; Imperial Hungarian General's parade tunic; Third-Reich:  
correspondence file of initialed letters to and from Himmler with translations  
(report on effect of V-1 rockets on Great Britain, War news, personalities,  
etc.), daggers (RLB/Red Cross officer, SA, NSKK, etc.), swords, medals,  
cufftitles, insignia, peaked caps and helmets (Bahnschutz, Fire Police,  
Red Cross, etc.); US 1820's "bell crown" shako, Civil War "Tiffany"  
wrist-breaker, leather goods, excavated shell fragments with maps of  
locations; WWII uniforms, headgear, edged weapons, etc.; Lot from  
the estate of Dr. Frederick White, who worked on the Manhattan  
Project - includes a Government Certificate stating his work was  
"essential to production of the Atomic Bomb..." with lapel badge, etc.;  
Japanese WWI "Adrian" helmet with Red Cross cover, kyo-gunto sword;  
large book collection, posters, ethnographic  
weapons, etc...
