Displayed in its original Hans Irlbacher frame, "Listening Fauns" was exhibited at the Art Institute of Chicago, the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York, The Copley Society in Boston, and the Dallas Art Association's First Annual Exhibition of Contemporary and International Art in 1919. Then it disappeared, whereabouts unknown and out of the public eye for over 100 years. Until being discovered on the wall of a Kansas City, Missouri home last year, it was known only from black and white images in early 20th century fine art journals.

This important work by Franz Von Stuck, co-founder of the Munich Secession Movement, will headline our Summer Gallery Auction on August 17.
