

Mark Twain, *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer*, first American edition, first printing, Hartford, 1876. Estimate \$18,000 to \$25,000.






Robert Indiana, *Numbers*, poems by Robert Creeley complete set of 10 color screenprints, 1968.


Estimate \$20,000 to \$30,000.

George Washington, Autograph Letter Signed, as President, to Ebenezer Tucker, suggesting that parties interested in a tract of land name their price only after examining the tract, New York, 24 January 1790. Estimate \$25,000 to \$35,000.
