

Over 100 lots of historical and graphic material relating to the Americas and the far reaches of the globe. Included are some 40 plates by John James Audubon. Rare Americana ranges from an early printing of The Federalist to a letter from Walt Disney discussing a Hollywood starlet; travels across the globe include the Pacific with Captain Cook, and the first settlers in Australia; and a selection of fine artifacts by Native American artists demonstrate the meticulous bead and quill work of their craft.
