(Highlights: an important 19th Century chest of drawers attributed to Ebenezer Wheeler (see Shelburne Museum for a nearly identical example); an important and well-documented anniversary scherenschnitte found in Tryon, North Carolina and dating to circa 1780 (ex Ruth and James O. Keene Collection); a Connecticut high chest; and a large assortment of folk art, redware, stoneware, textiles, and decorative arts.

Fine art and furnishings from a notable central Ohio couple, including an original Alexander Calder gouache (purchased from Pace Galleries; New York), signed and numbered lithographs from Calder, Picasso, and others (with provenance); a limited-edition Joan Miro tapestry weaving; period Eames chair and ottoman; other mid Century furnishings, and decorative arts from multiple generations.

Choice period and reproduction furniture and decorative arts from estates and collectors throughout Ohio, New York, and Colorado: including period tiger maple furniture, a Luman Watson tall case clock, an exuberantly paint-decorated corner cupboard; custom reproductions by David T. Smith; redware, stoneware, iron utensils, treenware, and

textiles including period examples as well as reproductions by Lester Breninger, David Strawser, David Ellinger; period Continental furnishings; 20th Century furnishings by Maitland Smith; mid-Century decorative arts including a Wright aluminum patio cart and Capriani floor lamp; a selection of period Tiffany student lamps and Tiffany sterling serveware; paintings by Ammi Phillips, Prior-Hamblin school, Will Moses, Tella Kitchen, unidentified important and early oil on canvas of the Yosemite Valley; sterling silver; much, much more.
