Robert "Bob" Eigelberger was a long-time Palm Beach resident; known as a successful architect, developer, and preservationist of the "North End" of Palm Beach County. In 1988, he was honored with a prestigious award from the Preservation Foundation of Palm Beach for his work. He built luxury



homes on a 22-acre property owned by his wife, Susie Phipps Cochran, whose family's fortune came from steel, real estate holding, and horse breeding. The land was part of the Phipps family's real estate holdings and was appropriately named the Phipps Estate. He and his wife Suzy transformed a 6-acre tract into their own Mediterranean-style home named Casa Phippsberger, and with his interest in landscape architecture, transformed the parcel into a lush botanical paradise.


