

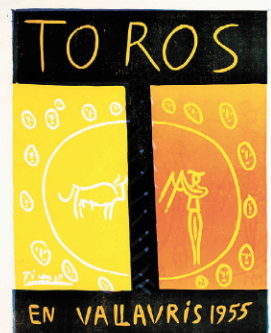

Pablo Picasso Signed Linoleum Cut Poster for Toros en Vallauris 1955



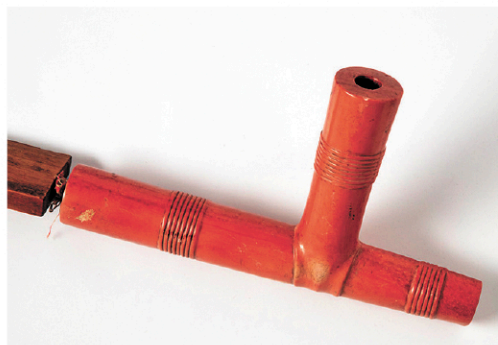

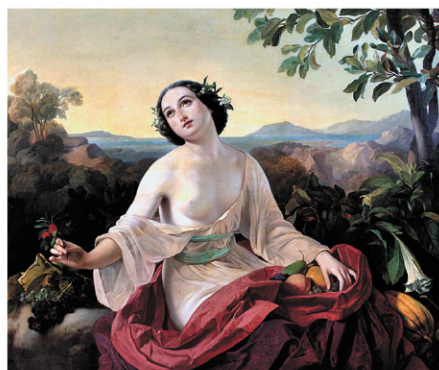

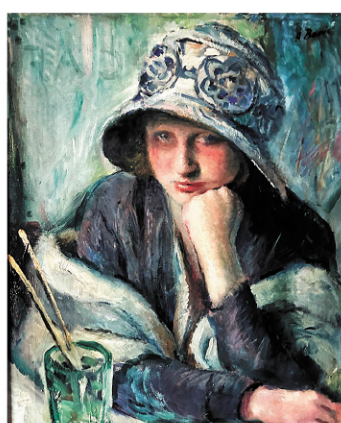
